



Kurdish Red Crescent has published a detailed report on the massacres committed by Turkish military and allied jihadist forces during their attack on Afrin Region of North Syria.



This report includes massacres committed by Turkish military and its affiliated jihadist armed groups from 20th to 31st of January 2018, as the number of victims increases on daily basis, and most of the wounded's situations are critical.

The 1st massacre on the first day of the Turkish airstrikes 20-01-2018

The Turkish military airstrikes targeted tens of locations in Afrin Region at around 16:00 in Turneda village. The attacks caused serious damages in people's houses and souls, and led to a massacre of a family from Idlib province taking refuge in Afrin region. All the family members were killed in the attack.

Hemada's family from Idlib were surprised by the sounds of the Turkish airplanes, the children went out to see what was going on, but when the mother rushed to get her children in, she saw them on the ground with their organs out of their bodies.

The nine-year old Yehya Hemeda lost his life; although the field doctors tried hard to save him. His brother Khaled Hemeda, eleven years old, suffered from serious injuries in his abdomen, and his situation is still critical, hoping he will come over soon.

The 2nd massacre on the second day of the Turkish airstrikes 21-01-2018

On the second day of the Turkish invasion on Afrin, al-Hussien family in Jalbul village in Sherawa district, was the target of the Turkish bombing. This miserable family who consists of three families together came from Idlib province, ran away from the conflict in that area and took refuge in Afrin, looking for a shelter for their children.

The family managed to get a house in Jalbul village and ran a chicken ranch, but the family faced an awful massacre, which left 11 of them dead, 8 wounded, and 5 missing members. Most of them were children and women.



The victims (who lost their lives) are:

1. Wael Al-Hussein, one- year old.
2. Salma Al-Hussein, six years old.
3. Mousab Al- Hussein, six years old.
4. Ghaliya Al-Hussein, eight years old.
5. Hedel Al-Hussein, ten years old.
6. Ahmed Al-Hussein seventeen years old.
7. Rehef Al-Hussein, thirty-three years old.
8. Bedar Al-Hussein, twenty-four years old.
9. Unknown.
10. Emad Shamo, twenty-nine years old.
11. Ahmed Rehmano, thirty-seven years old.

The wounded are:

1. Guma Mohemmed Al-Hussein, seventeen years old.
2. Hemeda Ibrahim, three years old.
3. Hesen Ibrahim Al-Hussein, two years old.
4. Fadi Mohemmed Eed, ten years old.
5. Ismail Mohemmed Ibrahim, twelve years old
6. Ibrahim Mohemmed Ibrahim, thirty-five years old.
7. Khaled Mohemmed Ali, thirty-six years old.

The 3rd massacre by the Turkish airstrikes 23-01-2018

Turkish forces along with the so-called Free Syrian Army (FSA) and other jihadist gangs bombed randomly the civilians in Jandairis district, where both Kurds and Arabs live together in peace.

The Turkish airstrikes focused on al-Hemam village, which is still under attack; the Turkish forces and their affiliated jihadist armed groups' bombings caused a horrible massacre of children, women and elderly people. The number of victims crossed 45 persons, among them 5 dead and 41 wounded.



The field medical centre there was also attacked and the Kurdish Red Crescent's ambulance was hit by several shots.

The victims (who lost their lives) are:

1. Unknown child, four years old.
2. Elmaza Shieko Horo, fifty years old.
3. unknown women, fifty-five years old.
4. unknown person, nineteen years old.
5. Gigar Khon, fifteen years old.

The 4th massacre by the Turkish airstrikes 26-01-2018

On this day, the bombs and rockets targeted nearly all towns, villages and areas in Afrin. This time the Turkish forces with its jihadist allies targeted Moubetan district, leading to a massacre of a family that was taking refuge in Afrin after fleeing Tel-Kirah town in North Aleppo. The 7 victims were from the same family (Al-Khater family).

Al-Khater family had come to Afrin looking for a safe shelter for their children. But unfortunately, they became a target of Turkish random bombing which destroyed their homes while they were sleeping in.

The family members who lost their lives:

1. Yousra Taha Al-Khater, nine years old.
2. Soulieman Taha Al-Khater, fourteen years old.
3. Zaky Taha Al-Khater, fifteen years old.
4. Moustefa Taha Al-Khater, seventeen years old.
5. Amena Taha Al-Khater, forty years old.
6. Taha Moustefa Al-Khater, forty-five years old
- 7- As for the seventh member, nineteen years old Safaa Taha Al-Khater, she had some minor injuries, the doctors assure that her psychological situation is very bad after she knew that all her family were dead.

The fifth massacre by the Turkish airstrikes 28-01-2018

Afrin people woke up shocked from an awful massacre in Gubela village in Sherawa district. Keno's family who consists of three families together came to Afrin region looking for a safe shelter and



better living. The family worked in grazing herds of sheep. According to the father (survivor), the Turkish aircraft bombed their houses with four rockets continuously, making the house fall to the ground. When the rescue team of the Kurdish Red Crescent arrived in the location, they found a yard full of parts of bodies to the extent that the team couldn't recognize the parts of humans' and herds'. The victims of this massacre were mostly children and women.

The eight members who lost their lives:

1. Kemal Keno, seven months old.
2. Safaa Keno, seven years old.
3. Hesén Keno, thirteen years old.
4. Hanedy Keno, fifteen years old.
5. Amera Keno, seventeen years old.
6. Jourya Keno, forty-five years old.
7. Fatema Abd Rebo, forty years old.
8. Rewan Al-Aswad twenty years old.

The rest were seriously wounded. The names of the wounded:

1. Abedallah Keno, fifty years old.
2. Mohemmed Abedallah Keno, twenty-seven years old.
3. Abedallah Mohemmed Keno, two years old.
4. Hesnaa Abedallah Keno, two years old.
5. Mehmoud Abedallah Keno, six years old.
6. Rehef Abedallah Keno, five years old.
7. Bedriya Abedallah Keno, eighteen years old.

The sixth massacre by the Turkish airstrikes 31-01-2018

The Turkish airstrikes once again targeted Afrin's Turindê village randomly. The brutal bombings caused a massacre of a miserable family who had already run away from the Turkish attacks in Jalema town. Aleko family were taking place in one of the basements in Turindê village as a temporary place. The reckless shell hit directly the basement, leading to many injuries and death of a child.
